All items received will be put on display at the Festival of Trees, hosted at the Red Brick Arts Centre and Museum, located at 4818-7th Avenue, Edson. From November 15th to November 18th, these items will be auctioned via an online auction.

Winning bids will be contacted by 4:30 pm on November 19th. Trees that are purchased through the auction will be delivered to the respective winners on Saturday, November 22th, 2025. All other auction items are required to be picked up by the winner from the Red Brick Arts Centre and Museum during our staffed hours of Monday-Friday, 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM.

DONATIONS

We appreciate donations of all types, including but not limited to; gift certificates, holiday gifts and décor, art, event tickets, wreaths, crafts, tools, toys, cash donations, and of course, trees. When donating for the auction, please provide the title of the entry, the name of the donor, and a brief description of the item. The title of the item will be listed on a card to identify your donation for the auction.

***All donations can be brought to our office during our regular staffed hours of Monday-Friday, 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM. No later than November 5, 2025.*

***Please Note*:** We kindly ask that all donated items be new with original packaging unless they are handcrafted items.

Tree donations may be set up and decorated at the Red Brick Arts Centre and Museum between the dates of October 30th to November 5th. Please call our office at 780-723-3582 to arrange a set-up time. Tree donations must meet the following criteria:

- Entries must be new, artificial, and include a tree skirt in the design
- Be not larger than 9 feet in height, and decorated on all sides
- Ornaments must be securely wired for easy transport.
